**PROPOSED FEE INCREASE  
AT ARROWHEAD CAMPGROUND  
UWHARRIE NATIONAL FOREST**

The Uwharrie National Forest is proposing to increase camping fees at the Arrowhead Campground in Montgomery County. Arrowhead Campground has paved roads and spurs, a large bathhouse with hot showers and flush toilets, electrical hookups, dump station, potable water, and a paved accessible perimeter walking trail. Campground hosts are on-site full time to assist the public with information. The campground is located near Badin Lake, Cove Boat Launch, and King's Mtn. Point; a developed day-use area with trails, picnic tables and shelter, and fishing piers. Additionally, the Uwharrie National Forest has a shooting range, off-road motorized trail system, hiking, mountain biking, and horse riding trails nearby open for the campers to use.

The fee increase proposed is due to inflationary reasons and increased costs of maintenance at Arrowhead Campground. The fees are used for utility costs for the campground, waste disposal, water and sewer services, cleaning and mowing of the campground, maintenance and replacement of facilities, and new amenities over time. The proposal is to have a transitional fee increase from the current fee of \$12 to \$15 for non-electric single sites in 2010 and then to \$18 in 2012. For electric single sites the increase proposed is from \$15 to \$20 in 2010 and then to \$25 in 2012. For the non-electric double sites the proposed increase is from \$24 to \$30 in 2010 and then to \$36 in 2012. For the electric double sites the proposed increase is from \$30 to \$40 in 2010 and then to \$50 in 2012.
