

# BADIN LAKE Campground



**B**ordering a lakeshore and under the shade of pines and hardwood, the 35 campsites of Badin Lake Campground offer a year-round retreat for swimmers, boaters and anglers. Boaters can launch trailered craft two miles away at the Cove Boat Ramp, and anglers can cast lines from many points along the shoreline.

## Cove Boat Ramp

For launching trailered boats, a boat ramp is located two miles south of Badin Lake Campground. To reach the Cove Boat Landing from the campground, travel south on Forest Road 597 and follow signs to the boat landing.

## Badin Lake Trail


Beginning at Cove Boat Ramp, the trail follows Badin Lake's shore for half of its distance and loops back through hardwood forest to the boat ramp. You can hike a 2.7 mile-loop or tackle the entire 6.2-mile trail.

## Kings Mtn. Point

King's Mountain Point day-use area is a perfect place for group outings. Situated on King's Mountain Point—a peninsula jutting into Badin Lake—the area boasts four accessible fishing piers, paved parking for 50 cars, and an accessible paved trail that circles 34 picnic sites. Each picnic site has a grill and table. A drinking water faucet and vault toilet are nearby.

## Campground Rules

- Checkout is 2 p.m. Checkin is 4 p.m.
- No more than two vehicles may be parked in each camping spur.
- Keep your fire in the grill, and make sure the fire is dead out before leaving.
- Don't play loud music or make other loud noises from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Horses are not allowed in the campground.
- Hunting with firearms is prohibited along Badin Lake Trail, because of the high concentration of people within the area.



**DIRECTIONS TO BADIN LAKE:** From Troy, take NC 109-N for 10 miles; turn left at Badin Lake sign and go 0.25 mile. Take Forest Road 576 west (gravel) for three miles. Follow the signs.

## Calling all anglers

Anglers may fish the shoreline of Badin Lake from numerous points along Badin Lake Trail. In addition, a favorite casting spot—a floating pier—is located on Kings Mountain Point's north side.

## Campsite features

Open year-round, the campground offers 35 sites for tent or trailer camping. Each site has a picnic table, grill, lantern post and tent pad.



Other amenities include water spigots for drinking water, showers and flush toilets.

The campground is suitable for car camping, but no hook-ups are available for RVs.

You can launch your canoe from the lake's border or drive two miles to the Cove Boat Ramp to launch a trailered boat.

**CAMPGROUND FEE:** \$12 per site, per night. Double-size sites are \$24 per night.
