How to start vncserver at boot

## There are at least 2 approaches

- Method 1 (simplest)
  - Use raspi-config to start the desktop at boot
    - sudo raspi-config and select Enable boot to Desktop
  - Follow the directions in Running VNCServer at Startup to put autostart instructions in your .config directory
- Method 2 (described here)
  - Place a control script in the /etc/init.d directory
  - Enable dependency based boot sequencing with the command:
    - update-rc.d /etc/init.d/vncboot defaults
