

How to start vncserver at boot

There are at least 2 approaches

- Method 1 (simplest)
 - Use **raspi-config** to start the desktop at boot
 - ***sudo raspi-config*** and select ***Enable boot to Desktop***
 - Follow the directions in ***Running VNCServer at Startup*** to put autostart instructions in your `.config` directory
- Method 2 (described [here](#))
 - Place a control script in the `/etc/init.d` directory
 - Enable dependency based boot sequencing with the command:
`update-rc.d /etc/init.d/vncboot defaults`
